# 3 Aspects of Bible Study

- Synthesis – big picture
- Exegesis – details
- Analysis – categories/topics
- All 3 aspects are exegetical, not eisegetical

- Pneumatology – study of the Spirit
- Angelology – study of angels
- Anthropology – study of mankind

- Hamartiology – study of sin
- Soteriology – study of salvation
- Israelology – study of Israel
- Ecclesiology – study of the church
- Eschatology – study of last things

- 161 references
- 11:33-12:2
- Notice “of God” in ch.1:
  - Gospel of God 1:1
  - Son of God 1:4
  - Beloved of God, Grace and peace of God 1:7
  - Will of God 1:10
  - Power of God 1:16
  - Righteousness of God 1:17
  - Wrath of God 1:18
  - That which is known of God 1:19
  - Glory of God 1:23
  - Truth of God 1:25
  - Ordinance of God 1:32

# What Does Romans Say About...

- Jesus (Christology)
- 38 references
- Who is He?
  - 1:4, 5:15, 5:21 (Jn 20:28)
- What does He do?
  - Notice the use of “in/through”
  - 2:16, 3:22, 3:24, 5:1, 5:17, 5:21, 6:11, 8:1, 8:39
  - Bottom line: God’s connection to man is exclusively through Christ (Jn 14:6, 1 Tim 2:5)

# What Does Romans Say About...

- The Holy Spirit (Pneumatology)
- 34 references (to pneuma)
- Who He is
  - 8:9, 8:26 (Himself, the Spirit)
  - Spirit of God, of Christ – (notice the Trinity)
- What He does
  - 5:5, 8:9, 8:11, 8:14, 8:16, 8:26
