He is Given to Us: 3 Implications

- He is a pledge
 - Eph 1:13-14, 2 Cor 1:21-22
- He is God's personal expression of love
 - Rom 5:5
- He is our security
 - 1 Jn 3:24







He is a Person

- He is one Person of the Trinity
 - Deut 6:4, Is 48:12,16, Mt 28:19, Gal 4:6
- He is Holy
 - Is 6, Rev 4, Is 63:11
- He is both Deity and Person
 - -1 Jn 3:24
- He is distinct from Father and Son
 - Mt 3:16-17, 28:29, Lk 3:21-22, Jn 16:14, 17:4, 2 Cor 13:14, Jude 20-21

He is a Person

- He is subordinate to Father and Son
 - Jn 14:16,26
- He is described with personal pronouns
 - Jn 15:26, 16:13-14, Acts 13:2
- He acts as a Person
 - Acts 2:4, Heb 10:29, Mt 12:31, Is 63:10, Eph 4:30, Acts5:3, Gen 6:3, Lk 12:12, Jn 16:7, Rom 8:26, 1 Cor 2:10

He Works

- He was involved in creation
 - Gen 1:2, Job 26:13, 33:4; Ps 33:6; 104:30
- He strives, restrains, and convicts
 - Gen 6:3, Jn 16:7-11, 2 Thes 2:6-8
- He is involved in giving, preserving word
 - Eph 6:17, 2 Tim 3:15-17, 2 Pet 1:20-21
- He intercedes
 - Rom 8:26-27, 34.

He Works

• In the OT: fills, comes upon

- Ex 31:3, 35:31, Deut 34:9, Ezek 43:5, Mic 3:8



He Works

- In the church age: baptizes
 - Mt 28:19, 1 Cor 12:12-13, Tit 3:5, Jn 3:6, 10:10, 2 Cor.5:17, 1 Pet. 1:23
- In the church age: seals
 - Eph 1:13-14, 4:30
- In the church age: indwells
 - Jn 7:37-39, Acts 11:17, Rom 5:5, 8:9-11, 1Cor 2:12, 3:16, 6:19-20, 12:13, 2 Cor 5:5, Gal 3:2, 4:6, Eph 2:22, 2 Tim 1:14, Jam 4:5, 1 Jn 3:24, 4:13.

 - Mt 16:13-20, Acts 1:5,7, 2:4-38, 8:14-17, 10:34-48, 11:16, 19:1-7




- Terms and Definitions

 - Rom 12:1-2. The Basis: Rom 12:1
- Walk in Him
 - Gal 5:15-26. The Basis: Gal 3:1-2,5:1,13,25
- Use what He gives us
 - 1 Pet 4:10-11. The Basis 1 Pet 1:3-5,22-23
